LOCKER DAYS

Unfortunately, we will not be able to host our normal Locker Day this school year. You and your child will be able to log on to the parent and student portal on August 18, to see their team and classes at that time.

We will be sending home a video at a later date that shows various important parts of our campus and our school building for both parent and student use. WMS staff will be well prepared to help all students transition and to navigate the building.

LOCKERS

Students will not be assigned lockers for the upcoming school year and will, instead, be asked to carry their supplies with them throughout the school day in their backpacks.

MASKS

All staff and students will be required to wear a mask on buses and during the school day. Teachers will let students know if appropriate social distancing is possible in the classroom, and students will be allowed to take their masks off when they are in the cafeteria.

STUDENT CHROMEBOOKS

New eighth grade students and all seventh grade students will receive a Chromebook for the 20-21 school year. Returning students should still have the device issued to them last year. Be on the lookout for an important email soon that will inform you about signing the electronic acceptable use policy and optional device insurance. We will also have a plan at a later date to get devices to students in our Virtual Academy.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

The district school supply list for middle school students is posted on the district webpage for your convenience and is accessible through this link:

At the bottom of the list, it states, "There may be up to \$10 in additional supplies needed. Specifics will be communicated through your child's team." Plan to receive this additional information from your child's team teacher.

Also, many of the items marked as collected and shared will now be for individual school use only. Exceptions would be facial tissue, hand sanitizer, and sanitizing wipes.

WATER BOTTLES

WMS students will be allowed to carry water bottles, as drinking fountains will be off-limits. Water bottle fillers will be installed in each hallway, but are not in place yet. We ask that all students come to school with their filled water bottles, labeled with their name. Soda, Gatorade, Powerade, flavor-adds, etc. are not acceptable as their spills will cause unnecessary cleaning problems for our staff. Teachers will be provided with paper cups that they can provide to students to use if they do not have a water bottle.

CELL PHONES

Electronic devices should not be seen or heard from the time students enter the school building until they exit for the end of the day. They should be turned off and remain stored securely in backpacks.

ARRIVAL TO SCHOOL

Buses will unload and doors will be opened for student entry at 7:10 AM.

Any students who arrive at school before 7:10 AM will be asked to enter and stay in our school lobby and will be required to wear their masks.

Once students enter the building they have the option of proceeding to the cafeteria to eat breakfast or directly to their first core classroom.

DRESSING OUT FOR PE

Locker rooms will not be utilized for at least the beginning of the school year and students will not be required to dress out for physical education. They should plan to have appropriate footwear and clothing for physical education on the days they have that class.

OPEN HOUSE

Open House this year will be held virtually. The date is Wednesday, September 9. We will send more details about this event as they become available.

The District is providing an alternative to the Back to School Fair this year and hosting a school supply distribution event on Saturday at Liberty High School


