

What it Looks Like to be a 6th Grader at Crossroads

Our 6th graders will follow a typical middle school schedule including switching classes throughout the day. They will have a homeroom (sixth hour classroom) where they can keep their backpacks. Between classes, there will be a passing period which students can use to go to the restroom. Our 6th grade classrooms will be located in the hallway past the gym and cafeteria. (Rooms 213, 215, 217, 218, 219, 220, 222, 228)

Sports are not offered to middle school students until 8th grade, however 6th grade students will be able to participate in clubs and intramural sports. More information will come as soon as we know which teachers will be sponsoring the clubs and intramural sports.

The Core classes our 6th graders take are Social Studies, English Language Arts, Math, and Science. In addition, 6th grade students enjoy elective classes. These core and elective classes are scheduled with an "A" and "B" day schedule. The first day of school will follow the A day schedule, the second day will follow the B day schedule, the third will be an A day, etc. If there is a day of school missed due to inclement weather, the missed day will be added to the end of the year.

On their schedule you will see a class called Core Plus. During Core Plus, they will return to their Core teachers for enrichment activities, additional work completion opportunities, help, and support. If you are a Horizons student, you will have Horizons every day during the Core Plus times here at Crossroads.
