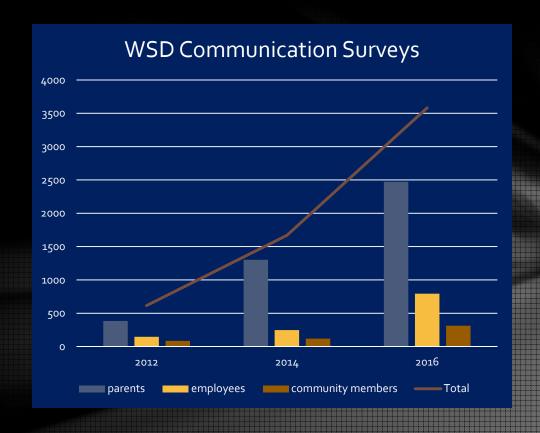

#### Who Responded...

This spring the 2016 WSD Communications Survey was sent out to parents and employees via email, text, push notification, Facebook and Twitter, posted on the District website, school websites, included in both Employee and District eNews, and shared in school newsletters. This year we had 3,045 respondents compared to 1,424 in 2014 and 498 in 2012. Parents, employees and community members responded to a variety of questions about District and building level communications efforts.



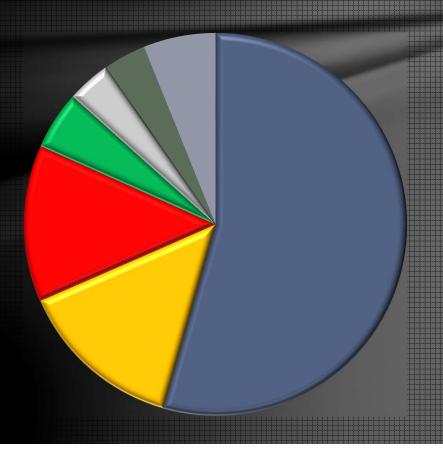
We started these annual surveys in 2011 and we conduct Parent Satisfaction Surveys in odd years and Communications Surveys in even years...

I didn't know WSD was on Twitter 8%

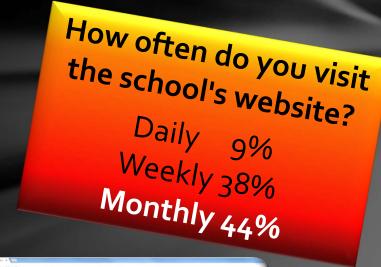
Overall how would you rate communication between the District and parents?

- 5. School newsletter

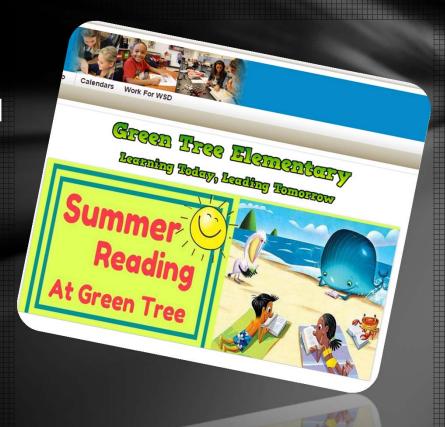




#### **School Websites**

School administrators respond to my questions in a timely manner. 72% agree (76%...68%)
