The PS Survey is administered every two years and this is the second time we have comparison data since the first PS Survey was done in 2013.




Who Responded...

During the months of April and May, the survey was emailed and texted to parents, posted on the District website, District Facebook page, Tweeted out and included in both the District and Employee eNews.

We had 3,151 responses (compared to 3,000 in 2015 and 2,500 in 2013).





Survey Topic areas

Parents with children at multiple buildings were able to answer the survey more than once to provide feedback on individual schools. Questions were broken down into seven categories:

- 1. Instruction
- School Safety,Discipline, and Character
- 3. School Culture
- 4. Administration
- 5. Communication
- 6. Support Services
- 7. Shift to K-6
















I feel that my student's discipline issues are handled fairly.




My student's teacher maintains discipline without being overly harsh or rigid.
































I feel that custodial/janitorial services at my school meet my student's needs.


Library services at my school meet my student's needs.




I feel that technology and computer services at my school meet my student's needs.




Nursing services at school meet my student's needs.





I understand and support the District's decision to move to K-6 elementary buildings.





I'm satisfied with the K-12 boundaries and where my child(ren) will attend school next year.





I'm confident 6th grade students will have the same educational experience in the WSD, regardless if they are located in a middle school or elementary building.



<u>Summary</u>

- >84% of parents agree that our teachers have high expectations for student achievement
- >82% of parents would recommend their school to other parents
- >72% believe character education makes a positive impact in their school
- The percentage of parents who feel that their child might have experienced bullying is about 23%, and the national average is about 33%
- While the majority of respondents feel welcome and respected at their child's school, it could be more so... (153 respondents indicated they do NOT feel welcome)

<u>Summary</u>

- >Those buildings and grounds sure are kept nice!
- We really like our principals, they are there when we need them
- My school does a GREAT job of keeping me well informed
- >80% of respondents are satisfied with the new boundaries and where their child will attend school
- And don't forget the 579 additional comments, everything ranging from "the café is loud" to "I wish foreign language was offered beginning in kindergarten" and "our son isn't the easiest and yet the teachers and staff have been super supportive."

Building Level Communication

Next Spring we will once again send out the Communications Survey which will be yet another measure of how well we are keeping our stakeholders informed, which helps drive PARENT SATISFACTION.

This year there were 3,151 responses to the Parent Satisfaction Survey, and 95% of parents who responded agreed that "my school keeps me well informed of school activities" and that's a number we should all be proud of!
