














As a special needs educator, I see the importance of special needs children having access to education; however, it is not fair to the majority of the other students to have their belonging broken, food eaten, personal belongings stolen or safety compromised at school. The special needs children need more assistance in class (and in Chautauqua!) so as not to take away the teacher's time and attention away from teaching the majority. Would someone please consider a "class-within-a-class" (CWC) approach for some of these children so that the regular education children are not shorted? It is distracting to a teacher and the other students when another child is being aggressive, loud or breaking rules. This has been a tough journey for me to balance the needs/rights of the special education kids with the regular education kids and the teachers.
