




KATIE REICHLE SOFTBALL SENIOR

ASHLYN SANDERS GOLF SENIOR


Ashlyn recently completed her high school golf career

HANNAH REEB SWIMMING SENIOR


Senior Hannah Reeb is a three-sport studentathlete at Holt, part of





COOPER SWIFT BASKETBALL SOPHOMORE




Swift has appeared in all of Liberty's games

NATHAN UNDERTAJLO WRESTLING **SENIOR**


Nathan Undertajlo recently placed sixth at the State Championships
