# Building expectations

#### Safe

- Always use materials properly.

- Be where you belong.

- Be prepared for daily activities.
- Work together.
- Clean up after yourself and others.
- Take care of personal and community property.

- Follow directions.
- Use appropriate voice levels.
- Listen to the speaker.
- Use kind words and actions.





# Hallway expectations


#### Safe

Short, straight and silent.

## Responsible

Go to your destination, directly.

- Greet others politely.
- Yield to younger students.
- Voice level = 0





# Bathroom expectations

#### Safe

- Keep water in the sink.
- Keep your feet on the ground.

## Responsible

- Wash your hands with soap and water.
- Place all trash in the trash bin.
- Return to class quickly.



- Respect privacy of others.
- Be quick and quiet.
- Flush the toilet.



# Digital Citizenship

#### Safe

## Responsible

- If walking, carry devices with both hands.
- When leaving classroom, leave devices locked in assigned areas.

- Use devices for educational/school purposes only.
- Keep passwords private.
- Use equipment carefully and appropriately.



- Use proper "netiquette."
- Follow copyright rules.
- Use only your assigned device.



# Playground Expectations

#### Safe

- Follow building playground rules.
- Use P.E. rules for team sports.
- Walk on gravel, running allowed in grass.

# Responsible

- Follow triple whistle.
- Sit silently in line at assigned place until picked up.



- Include and encourage others.
- Share equipment.
- Take turns.



# Cafeteria expectations

#### Safe

- Eat your own food with your mouth closed.
- Find a seat quickly and stay in your seat.

## Responsible

- Collect all needed items before sitting down.
- Clean up after yourself and others.



- Enter and remain quiet.
- Encourage and include others.
- Raise hand and wait patiently.



# Appival and Dismissal Safe Responsible

- Car riders walk in line to safety spot and wait for teacher OK to go to number and enter car.
- Bus riders walk on sidewalk to buses.

- When dismissed, walkers and car riders walk directly to the gym.
- Car riders listen for name to be called while waiting in the gym.



- Car riders and walkers sit cris-cross, with a level 0 voice in lines while waiting in gym.
- Walk in short, straight, silent lines when going to buses, gym or classrooms.

Responsible

- Stay seated and face the front.
- KFHOOTY

• Enter and exit in a quiet line..

- Show positive appreciation to the presenter in an appropriate way.
- Listen to the presenter.




# Bus expectations
