

Participants' Bill of Rights School-Based MO HealthNet Services

Any student in the Wentzville R-IV School District receiving Private Duty Nursing Services and/or Personal Care Services delivered within the context of public school is assured of the following:

- 1. To be treated with respect and dignity in accordance with school board policy;
- 2. To have all personal and medical information kept confidential pursuant to applicable laws and board policy, including the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA);
- 3. To have direction over the services provided, as stated in the IEP, pursuant to the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA);
- 4. To be provided a copy of the District's established grievance procedure, including how to make a complaint about the services and receive cooperation to reach resolution, without fear of retribution;
- 5. To receive services without regard to race, creed, color, age, sex, or national origin, pursuant to law and school board policy; and
- 6. To receive a copy of this Bill of Rights.
